- Please be sure to pack your child's lunch in a labeled plastic container or lunch kit. **Please send a labeled water bottle to camp with your child.** This will enable him or her to have continual access to a cold drink at any time during the day. **No paper or plastic bags, please.**
- Campers may have opportunities for water play throughout the week depending on the schedule and if time allows. Please provide **towels, a swimsuit and/or a change of clothes. Please pack an extra mask for your camper.**

- **Please be sure that all clothing is labeled with your child's name** (equipment, swimsuits, and sneakers)
- **Please have your child leave electronic devices at home. Cell phones must be kept off and in their backpacks during the camp day.**
