

Refund Policy 2023

With the purchase of the Refund Protection Plan (\$50) for each week, per camper, and approval of a completed Refund Request Form, Germantown Academy will reimburse families 75% of the unused portion of camp fees for a complete withdrawal from the camper's program, minus the fee of refund protection.

All refund requests must be received no less than two weeks prior to the start of camp (this does not include medical requests).

In order to receive a full refund, or 100% of the camp fees minus refund protection, campers must be medically withdrawn from the program by providing a doctor's note. All refund requests will be approved by the Camp Director and processed in a timely manner. Vacations and other reasons your camper may not attend the program are to be sent to the office with no less than two weeks prior to the program beginning and only if the Refund Protection Plan has been purchased. Refund requests will not be sent to the Director unless refund protection has been purchased.

Refunds will not be given if an Act of God, fire, pandemic, or government restrictions or other cause beyond GA Summer Camps reasonable control, interrupts or substantially curtails GA Summer Camps regular operations, GA Summer Camps has sole discretion to extend, discontinue, or otherwise modify its operations, the camp season, its curriculum, employees' job duties, and any of its policies and procedures.

Partial refunds will not be granted for illness, vacation, or other instances that would exclude your camper from attending the full week.
